

Defamatory or Abusive Language

Usenet Postings That Violate Our Terms of Service (TOS)

Facilitating a Violation of our TOS

Advertising, transmitting, or otherwise making available any software, program, product, or service that is designed to violate this Terms of Service, which includes the facilitation of the means to spam, initiation of pinging, flooding, mail bombing, denial of service attacks, and piracy of software

Other Activities We Deem Harmful

Engaging in activities, whether lawful or unlawful, that Digital Mouse Designs determines to be harmful to its clients, including but not limited to:

The responsibility for avoiding harmful activities described rests primarily with the client.
